Program: Valencia Terrace

Tara Malle, Circle City Kiwanian and Valencia Terrace Sales Director spoke about the facility. But first, everyone enjoyed a pasta and salad lunch provided by Valencia Terrace.

Valencia Terrace is owned by Kisco and is now celebrating its 15th anniversary at the Corona location. Both independent and assisted living are offered.

Independent living includes one meal per day, housekeeping, utilities, local transportation, activities and check in once a day. Assisted living, with additional costs, in a separate wing, is licensed by the state and requires paperwork from a doctor, has a care pan with care services, includes three meals a day, laundry service and the other items listed in independent living.

Valencia Terrace is pet friendly, has a pool, library, game room and a variety of activities.

Prices for independent living: Studio, \$4,575; 1 bedroom, \$4,725; 2 bedrooms, \$5,925; casitas, \$7,100.

Prices for assisted living: Studio, \$3,950; 1 Bedroom, \$4,950; 2 bedrooms, \$6,425. Care cost- \$750-\$3,200.

One-time move in fee ranges from \$7,000-\$10,000.

Tara spoke about things to consider when looking for a senior living place: budget, proximity to family, pet friendly, resident population, online reviews, maintenance of the community, community atmosphere, friendliness of staff.

Tara then showed several apartments to give people an idea of the size and amenities.
